"Intermediate Writing" is for practicing writing at a paragraph level, through these writing stages: Prewriting, Generating Ideas, Organizing Details and Writing Drafts, and Getting Feedback and Writing the Final Drafts. It suits any writing classes, especially classes at the university level.

This book provides exercises that will enhance students' thinking and planning before they actually write. It also provides a certain amount of basic knowledge and writing principles they need to acquire, such as how to analyze writing topics, how to write topic sentences, and so on. The textbook also includes seven different writing genres: Narration, Description, Process, Illustration, Effect-to-Cause, Comparison and Contrast, and Persuasion. These genres are illustrated by models and necessary explanations.

In addition, the book provides answer keys when necessary so that the book can be used for students' self-study.
